Year 11 Clearance Day – Thursday 28 June – 8.50am - 10.00am

Almost unbelievably, the last event of your child's compulsory education is upon us!

On Thursday 28 June, year 11 will meet for the final time. We will have a whole year assembly followed by book collection. At this time we will also issue the Summer Ball tickets.

We would ask that all year 11 students arrive at school at 8.50am and go straight to the main hall. They are expected to be in full uniform.

After the assembly they will go to the gym to hand in any textbooks to their form tutors. We regret that, unless each student has satisfactorily completed their examination courses and returned all their books, we will not be able to issue their Summer Ball ticket. We will also be unable to hand tickets to anyone other than the named person for security reasons.

The students will be dismissed once they have completed clearance which will be by 10.00am at the latest to give ample time for the preparations for the Summer Ball which, as you know, will take place at The Avisford Park Hotel from 6.30-10.00pm that day.

GCSE Results

Results will be published on Thursday 23 August between 10am and 11am. Students should go to the amphitheatre at the back of drama to collect their results. They should not come to the front office of the school as the doors will be locked.

If your child is asking someone to collect their results on their behalf, they need to write a letter to that effect stating who will be collecting the results. This letter must be signed by your child. The person collecting the results on your child's behalf needs to make sure they have some form of identification with them in case they are asked to provide it. All remaining results will be posted home.
