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# Courses Available

- **A level** - Academic study – Exam Focus – 3 mixed subjects
- **BTEC** - Applied study – Assessment + Exams – 1-3 subjects
- **Vocational** - Industry focussed – Assessment – Single subject
- **Apprenticeship** - On the job learning – College
- **Entry Route** - Pathway courses - Life skills + Independence



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# Which path is right for me?

- Do you know what career you want? If not **don't** worry.
- Check your last school report and **know your projected grades**
- Always check the entry requirements of every course you're interested in
- Think about what learning style works for you

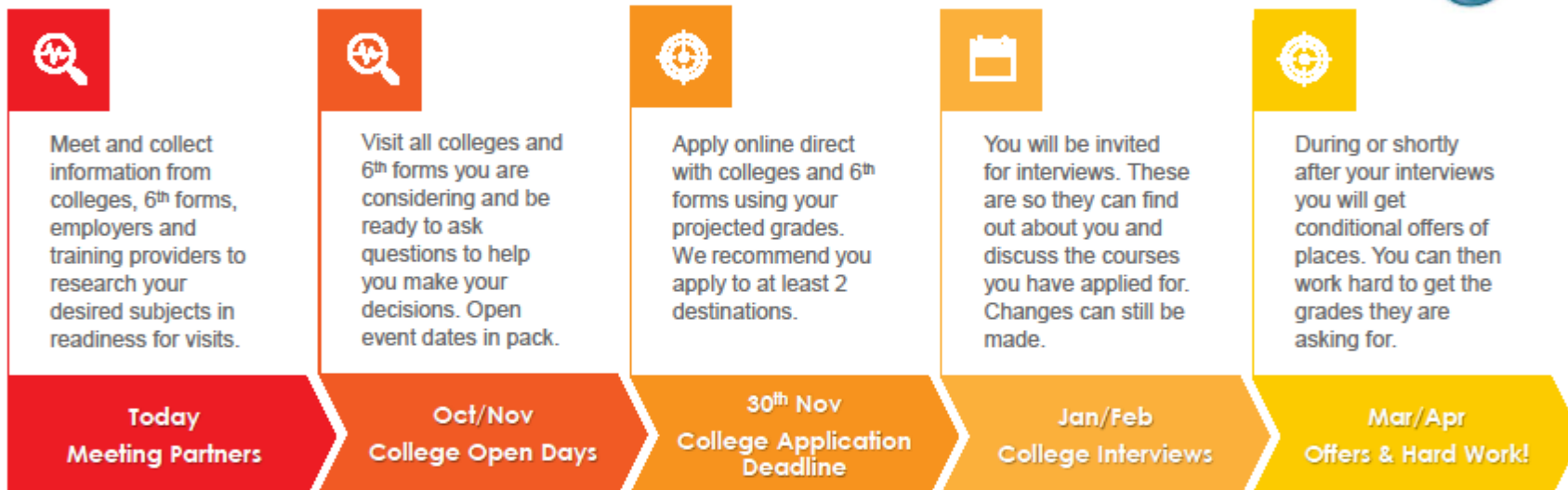
Course Level	Examples	Typical Entry Requirements	Extra Requirements
Level 3	A-Level + BTEC L3	5 GCSE's 4-9 inc Eng + Maths	Grade 6 in some subjects
Level 2	BTEC L2 + Vocational	3 GCSE's 3-9 inc Eng + Maths	Maths + English resits if needed
Level 1	Vocational	1-2 GCSE's 1-3	Maths + English resits if needed
Entry	Pathway	No Formal Requirements

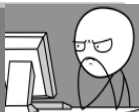

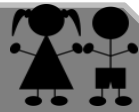

# Degree Apprenticeships

## (Higher & Degree Vacancy Listing for 2019 Recruitment)

### Pros

- Same level of qualification as a full-time degree
- Earn salary while you learn
- No loan to repay
- Social life (NUS card)
- Develops work ethic
- Suits some people's learning styles

### Cons

- Not always available locally
- Competition for vacancies
- Miss out on the full university experience
- Not as wide a range of options as full-time degree courses but ..... more Degree Apprentices are under development
