Create a list of possibles. Ask your family for opportunities and support. Talk to friends. Use the EBP Database for inspiration (See the How to Guide) Explore local comapnies on foot or on google. Remember you can create a positive experience anywhere and you may need a plan B or even a plan C!



Approach employers. Use e-mails, letters or direct introductions. Check the examples in the 'how to find a placement' guide. Introduce yourself and ask them if they will host you for the four days.
