Year 10 was a successful year for our current year 11 students and we wish to celebrate that with as many students as possible. This invite only event will give these students the recognition they deserve.


DHS- weekend musical.

Our school musical is one of the highlights for our performing arts department and we would love to have you come along and watch our students go beyond their best.


Year 10 consultation evening.
