Tracking your child's academic progress

We have three key tracking points (TP) throughout year 11:

- TP4. Results sent home 21st October.
- TP5. Results sent home 20th January.
- TP6. Results sent home 22nd April.

As was the expectation throughout Year 10, between these TP's your child will be expected to revise key topics and practice exam strategies at home as well as in school. Teachers will be setting homework and revision on Arbor. A list of revision materials and resources for all subject areas can be seen below and on our school website.

In the weeks prior to the tracking point dates above, your child will sit a series of examinations across all subjects. Tracking points provide the class teacher with key information regarding where your child is currently working, this information will be shared with you and your child. The information from tracking points is also used to amend curriculums to ensure they are designed to give your child the best possible chance to achieve excellent outcomes at the end of their GCSE journey.

Tracking point reports communicate the students current GCSE grade and projected GCSE grade. The grades are numbered from 1-9, for those of you new to the 1-9 system I have included a useful comparison table below:

Year 11 Mock Exam Support Evening - Thursday 23rd October

The structure of GCSEs continues to evolve, making the **Mock Exam Support Evening** a valuable opportunity to gain insight into what lies ahead and how to best support your child in performing really well in the TP5 exams (these will provide the traditional 'mock' results that inform important decisions about next steps such as aspirational college destinations and courses of study).

As with the Year 10 TP3 summer exams, the Year 11 TP5 exams will endeavour to mimic the actual GCSE exam experience in that they will not be sat in classrooms but in the examination hall. This provides more valuable real-world exam experience for students in regard to how they are expected to behave and approach each paper they sit.

We will be holding a **Mock Exam Support Evening** on **Thursday 23rd October**, starting at **5:30pm** in the **Performing Arts Centre**. During the evening, we will guide you through the examination process, the support available in school, and how parents and carers can help students at home.

Much of the session will focus on **practical strategies** to support effective revision and build positive study habits. As teenagers are not always the most forthcoming with information - but still want you to understand what they're going through - this evening will help bridge that gap. Students are welcome and strongly encouraged to attend alongside you.

How to revise effectively

Effective revision is crucial to your chances of success in your GCSE exams. It is important that you have revised sufficiently and in the correct way to make sure you are prepared for your exams.

Strategies such as re-reading your notes or highlighting large parts of the revision guide may feel like you are doing revision, but in the long run will have little to no impact on your ability to remember the information. The Learning Scientists (a group of cognitive scientists), have recommended six effective revision strategies, here are the three most important:

Spaced Practice	Create a study schedule that chunks up your study and ensures you look at each subject little and often - for example do 20 or 30 minutes on each subject every few days rather than 2 or 3 hours on a subject once a month.
Retrieval Practice	Test yourself from memory before looking at any notes or revision guides. Blanked out knowledge organisers work well for this as well as flashcards (tips on how to use both of these via the videos below).
Elaboration	Make connections between the different ideas you are learning in class and explain ideas in as much detail as you can. You can use flashcards for this by adding two extra bits of knowledge to each correct answer.
